PLEASE READ THE EXCLUSION OF LIABILITY AND ASSUMPTION OF RISK NOTICE BELOW

By accepting and signing this Eagle Valley Snowmobile Club Membership, I agree to save harmless and keep indemnified the Province of B.C., any landowner from which the Eagle Valley Snowmobile Club's (E.V.S.C.) trail system operates and the E.V.S.C. and its members, directors, officers, employees, and their respective agents, officials, servants and representatives from and against all claims, actions, costs and expenses and demands in respect to death, injury, loss or damage to my person or property or to the person or property of any driver or passenger operating the aforementioned permitted snowmobile, howsoever caused, arising out of or in connection with the use of the E.V.S.C. trail system, notwithstanding that the same may have been contributed to or occasioned by the negligence of said bodies, or any of them, their agents, officials, servants or representatives. It is further understood and agreed that this agreement is binding upon myself, my heirs, executors, administrators and assigns.

I hereby expressly waive any and all claims I may have and hereby expressly release from liability the Province of B.C., the British Columbia Snowmobile Federation (B.C.S.F.), the E.V.S.C., their members, their employees, agents, representatives and contractors for any loss or damage to property or personal injury, including death, which I may suffer or be subjected to as a result of my participation in activities on Province of B.C., B.C.S.F. or E.V.S.C. trails or property, arising out of any cause whatsoever, including without limitation, the negligence of the Province of B.C. or B.C.S.F. or E.V.S.C. or any of said members, employees, agents, representatives or contractors.

I am aware that snowmobiling presents certain dangers and I accept full responsibility for the risks inherent in such an endeavor. Such dangers include but are not restricted to travelling into mountainous or forested terrain which in their natural state presents many obstacles and hazards.

Obey all signs. Obey all Provincial laws governing the operation of a snowmobile, Property Trespass Act and Local Municipal By-Laws pertaining to snowmobiling.

Know and adhere to the Snowmobilers Code of Ethics.
