Reporting to the General Manager, part-time and full-time seasonal Ticket Booth Attendants are ambassadors for the Club and will undertake their duties in a responsible and friendly manner. Shifts are from 7am through to 2pm, 7 days per week from December 6 – April 15 (snow dependant). With the number of shifts depending on seniority and demand.

This position will be responsible for a variety of tasks including, but not limited to:

- Collection of cash, debit, and credit card payments from customers
- Answering customer questions as they arise
- Making cash change accurately and efficiently
- Issuing receipts to customers
- Cleaning workspaces and outbuildings
- Maintaining control over cash register drawer and verifying amounts are correct
- Opening and closing the ticket booth

As an Eagle Valley Snowmobile Club employee, it is your responsibility to follow the Club's safety and best practices to the best of your ability, as well as maintain a friendly and positive attitude every day with all guests and employees.

- Ability to perform basic math easily and quickly

- Minimum 20 hours per week
